### Guidelines

- Shape: Round
- Size: Minimum 12" – Maximum 36" in diameter
- Medium: Must use 50% eco-friendly material (however, 100% is encouraged)
- Presentation: Must be able to stand on its own

### Judging Criteria

1. How much ecofriendly material was incorporated into artwork.
2. Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the theme Malama i ke kai (take care of the ocean)
3. Artistic creativity/original ideas
